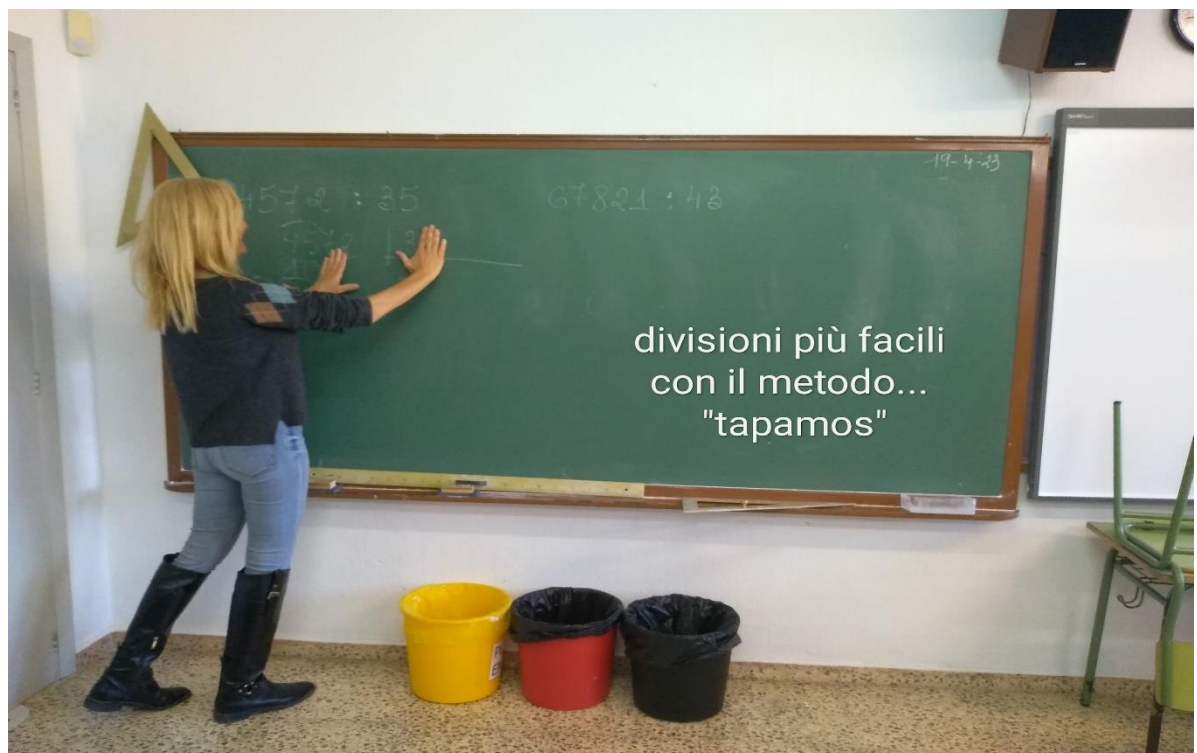
Warming up: oral calculation. The teacher writes on the blackboard what is shown below:

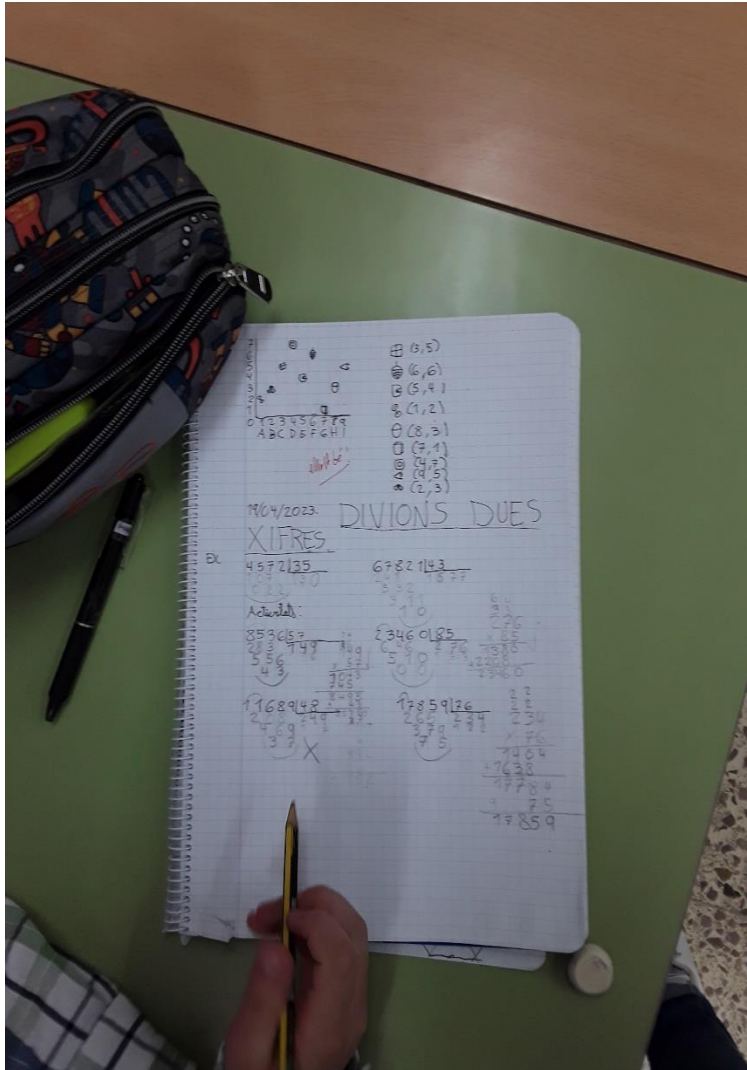

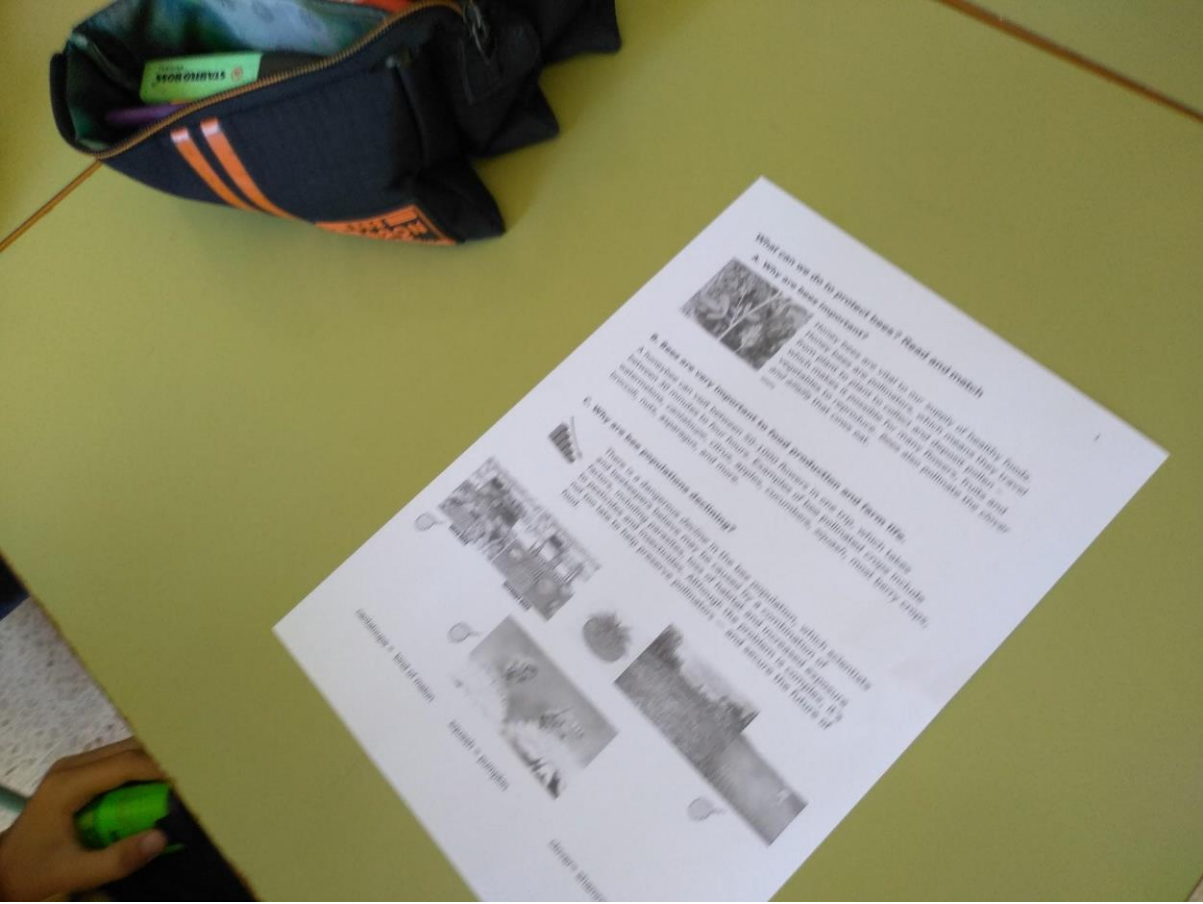

What can we do to protect bees? Read and match.



A. Why are bees important?

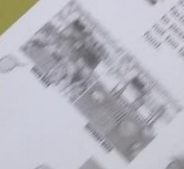
Bees have an important role to play in our supply of healthy foods. Many foods are pollinated, which means they travel from plant to plant to allow and deposit pollen. This makes it possible for many flowers, fruits and vegetables to reproduce. Bees also pollinate the clover and alfalfa that cows eat.

B. How are bees important to food production and farm life?

A honey bee can visit around 1000 flowers in one trip, which takes about 10 minutes in the field. Quantities of bee-pollinated crops include vegetables, seedless citrus, apples, cucumbers, squash, most berry crops, nuts, apricots, and more.

C. Why are bee populations declining?

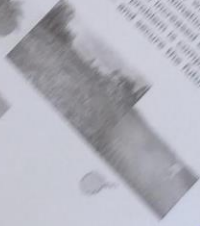
There is a dramatic decline in the bee population, which scientists say is a dangerous trend. This has been caused by a combination of factors, including parasites, loss of habitat and increased exposure to pesticides and herbicides, although the problem is complex. It is not clear how to help preserve pollinators – and secure the future of food.

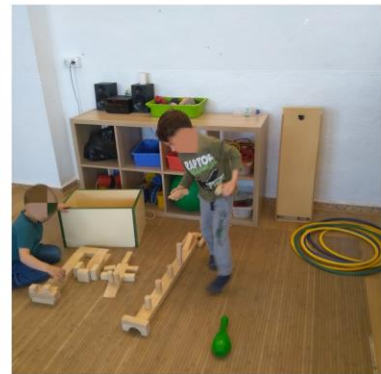
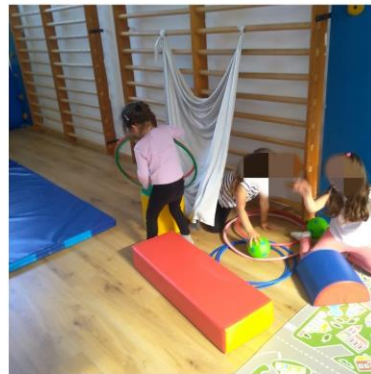




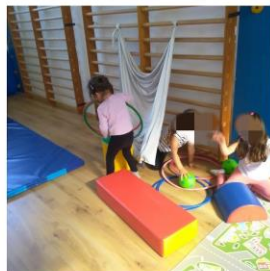
April 20th:
